Through this partnership a friendship was developed that we are thankful to have had. We tip our hats to him this time of year when we remember his 2013 ride from these earthly pastures.

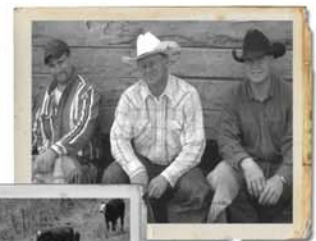
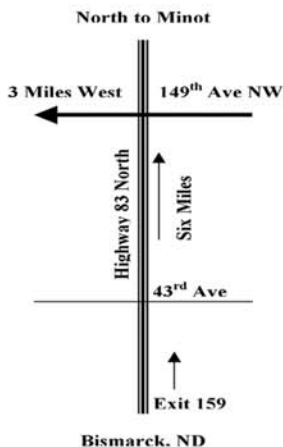
The Hetletved Quarter Horse program offers the highest concentration of High Rolling Roany with the largest band of High Rolling Roany daughters (owning 60%) as well as two HRR sons in the stud battery. We are excited to see our planning and breeding come to fruition with a foal product that makes us proud. These Roany descendents are known for their uniformity, maternal traits, and saddle-fitting withers for covering big country with good foot and bone.

The Hetletved Quarter Horse Ranch is a family-run business that consists of a horse breeding and cattle operation located near Robinson, North Dakota. Gene and Jan Hetletved operate the ranch with the help of their sons, Lee and Clint, and families. Gene and Jan run a cow-calf operation, farm some acreage, and the Dakota Hills Hideaway hunting lodge. Gene is main strategist and pedigree man. Jan is the main photographer of all of our foal pictures. We enjoy our horses and strive to make them nice to look at while they are being used. We work cattle the old fashioned way by dragging them to the fire. Our horses are not strangers to the chores that a ranch requires. It won't matter if you are looking to check those yearlings that refuse to stay in or wanting to stretch that corner fence that won't stay tight; we have a horse bred to take care of you. Ranch, performance, or show, we invite you to take a look.

Lee and Penny Hetletved own and operate LH Equine Center, a stable and equine event center. Lee is a teacher of agriculture at Wilton Public School, barn operator, and main horse trainer. Penny is the Director of Education for the ND Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, puts together the sale catalog, and recently graduated with her doctorate from USD. Kinley is horseback and has won many an award on Two Socks (HRR gelding) and Junior (Zan Gold Jackson gelding). Hatley is officially a youth rodeo participant with a serious need for speed--luckily our faithful Two Socks knows just how much speed to give her! She's finally of age to make the big ride when moving the cows back home in the fall. Both girls are avid archers who have won multiple state championships. There is no "OFF" season to archery.

Clint is the go-to man for mechanical expertise on the ranch. He operates a farm shop with Gene in Robinson where Clint and Gene weld custom panels. Clint also stays busy tending to his cow calf pairs, doing a bit of farming, haying, and trucking. His wife Lacey is a loan officer at Capital Credit Union. Jax Rolling Copper, a 1998 stallion, is a son of High Rolling Roany, born on our ranch out of one of Bub's mares, but raised by Bub Numm. Gene kept and rode "Copper" for two winters when Copper was younger. He carries many of his sire's characteristics with his strong build and large frame. His bottom side offers more crosses to Driftwood and Apple Jax.

We were able to purchase Copper in 2011 and are continually pleased about the consistency of his foals. Copper has a shocking resemblance to his sire, High Rolling Roany. His dam, High Rolling Copper, was an amazing producer for us. Copper has the disposition that High Rolling Roany is known for along with good bone, a kind eye, and a gentle manner. He is 75% High Rolling Roany, 10.16% Joe Hancock, and 9.38% Driftwood. He goes back to the legendary foundational sire legend, Peter McCue, seventeen times!

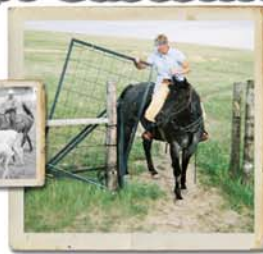

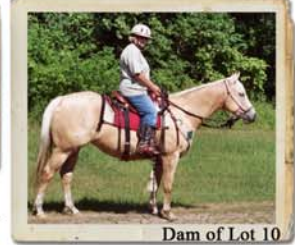

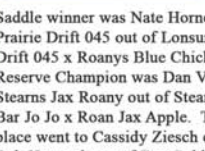

'Nick Mothershead started Roany,' Nunn recalls. 'After the first saddling he called me.' 'I thought you said that horse had never been rode,' he said. 'He hadn't.' I told him. On his first ride, Roany had behaved like a broke horse."

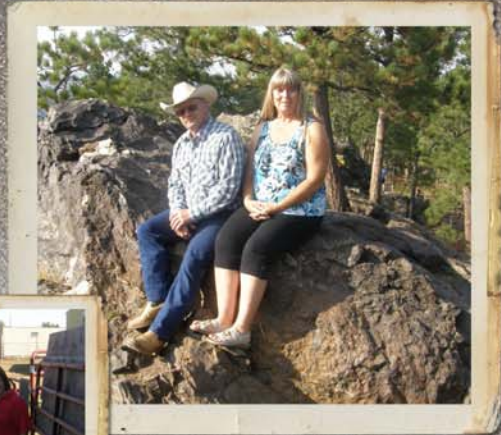
