Liability: Any person attending this sale does so at his own risk. Neither the owners, sale management, nor any other person connected with the sale assumes any liability, legal or otherwise.

Absentee Bids: Anyone wishing to bid who cannot attend the sale may place a phone or mail bid by contacting either ranch listed above. A letter of credit is required at least three days prior to sale date.

Registration and Transfers: All weanlings will sell with application for registration with AQHA. HQH foals will be registered with AQHA. HQH foals' papers will be mailed to the buyers once papers are received from AQHA. Transfers will be filled out sale day, so please remember to bring your AQHA membership ID number to the sale.

Terms and Conditions: Terms of this sale are cash, personal check, or cashier's check (US Funds). Driver's license or some other form of identification will be required for checks. The sale personnel will withhold registration papers for MRB horses until checks clear the bank. If any buyer wishes to obtain registration papers immediately, the horse must be paid for in currency or certified check. Every animal sells to the highest bidder with auctioneer, Seth Weishaar, settling any and all bid disputes. All horses are buyer's property as soon as the gavel drops. No delivery is available until final settlement is made on all purchases. Buyers must make arrangements for care of horses at their own risk until delivery is taken. Announced changes in the catalog information on sale day take precedence over printed material in this book. Every effort has been made to insure correctness of this catalog, but sellers assume no responsibility for errors or omissions. The auctioneer, announcer, employees, and sale management act as agents only for the sellers, but assume no liability for either the buyer or seller. The right to "NO SALE" the animal is reserved for all sellers, before they leave the sale ring.

Health: Health of these horses is excellent. Individual health papers with a Coggins test will be issued for shipment anywhere in the US. All Hetletved foals will be wormed, vaccinated, handled, and tied. Each Hetletved foal's halter will accompany foal to their new owner. Every MRB horse in the sale is, to the best of our knowledge, free of disease or defect. Known defect(s) will be called on sale day. A veterinarian will be on hand to aide you in further inspection of your prospective purchases.

Extras: The volume buyer for Saturday's Production Sale will be presented with foal feed courtesy of Diamond W Animal Essentials of Bismarck. The volume buyer for Sunday's Performance and Ranch Horse Sale will receive a piece of tack from the same sponsor. MRB's 2008 Ranch Horse Competitors will be going for a handmade buckle made by Darryl Howard of Bismarck, ND. A matching buckle will be given to the buyer of that champion horse on Sunday. The top three Ranch Horse Winners will get to pick their position in Sunday's Sale. We sell in catalog order both days.



Missouri River Breaks Performance & Ranch Horse Sale's Ranch Horse Competition Pattern



1. Open, enter, and close gate.
2. Dismount, lift all four feet.
3. Load and unload horse
4. For the sake of ties, there will be some sort of surprise element within this competition.
5. Take rope attached to a log, dally, and drag log around the barrel—return log to original spot.
6. Cross logs
7. Move to middle of arena to begin "figure 8" pattern. Begin at a slow lope to one lead, switch leads to the opposite lead to make the smaller "figure 8" pattern. Quicken pace to a faster lope for the larger "figure 8" pattern.
8. When finishing larger circle, bring horse out to a straight line.
9. Stop horse, settle, and back ten feet.
10. Turn or spin horse each direction. Proceed to round pen for cattle work.
11. Cattle work will be done after the dry work in a permanent 50-foot round pen. Once contestant has entered the round pen, the competitor will be scored on quietness, control, and time use. It is up to the discretion of the competitor as to what he/she shows within this portion.

*Six Minute Time Limit.
Competitor does not have to use all time allotted.*




